Theresa Lange Topic received her PhD in 1977 from Harvard University. She has conducted extensive fieldwork in northern Peru in both coastal and highland regions, with a particular focus on the Huamachuco area of the northern sierra. Her publications include discussions of complex societies and monumental architecture, prehistoric warfare and fortifications, Inca imperialism, ritual practice in prehistoric Andean contexts, and women in prehistory. She served in academic and administrative positions at Trent University in Peterborough, Ontario from 1974 to 1996. She then served as Academic Dean, Principal, and Professor at Brescia University College at Western University in London, Ontario, Canada. She is currently Professor Emerita at Brescia, and Adjunct Professor in the Department of Anthropology at Western University.
